The small, lightweight LTV provides sophisticated critical care ventilation in improvised environments. The LTV supports both invasive and non-invasive applications. It combines portability, impact-resistant construction, easy-to-read displays and comprehensive monitoring. It is a single solution for patients weighing 5 kilograms or more.

Weighing only 13.4 pounds, the LTV is a pick-up-and-go solution that can travel with patients from field care to transport to the ICU. It can take advantage of many 12-volt power sources — from cigarette lighters to wall outlet power — and its internal battery allows it to be transferred from one power source to the next without interruption.

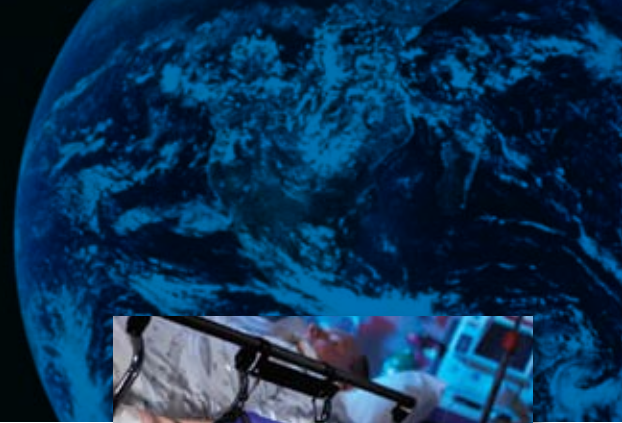
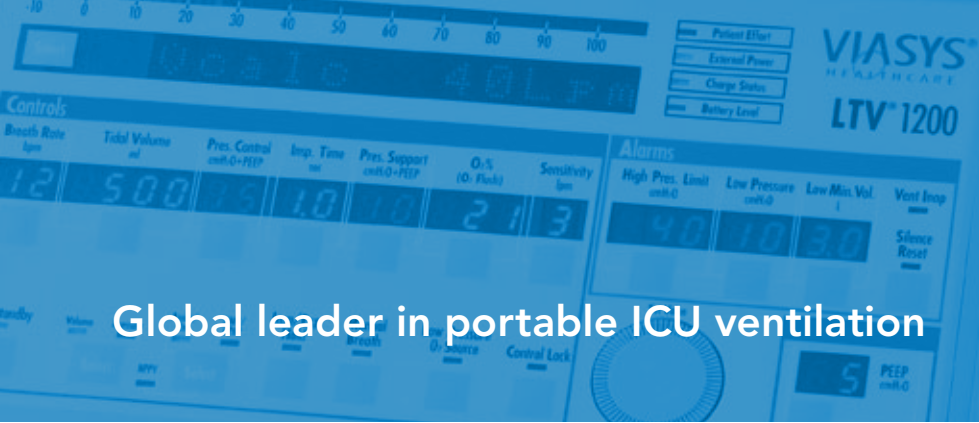
